In accordance with Section 8 item (f) of the HPIA Plan of Operations, effective immediately, the **Hawaii Property Insurance Association (HPIA) is not accepting any applications for new HPIA Homeowners and/or Dwelling Fire policies, requests to increase or change coverage, or reinstatements for property that is located within Leilani Estates and the surrounding areas experiencing volcanic activity. An evacuation order is in effect and a state of emergency has been declared in this area.**


This suspension will remain in force until civil authority has declared this area out of imminent danger. You will be notified when this suspension is lifted.
